

BMI teams up with ORNL and RDAV for a new High Performance Computing project

A new joint project between Emory's Department of Biomedical Informatics, Oak Ridge National Laboratory and Remote Data Analysis and Visualization Center (RDAV) at University of Tennessee proposes using image analysis pipelines, high performance computing mechanisms and scalable I/O tools to carry out machine learning methods and correlative analyses on large volumes of image data.
